4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.			
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.			
4.3.	No unlicenced driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.			
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.			
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.			
4.6.	No engine starts any day before 9.00am.			
4.7.	Once the Track gate(s) are closed and karts start moving, there will be no further entry or exit of karts, persons or equipment to the Track, until the completion of practice/racing and all karts are stopped.			
4.8.	The Sand greyhound track is off-limits during race days. All spectators must remain behind the colorbond fence bordering the Track.			
4.9.	Overnight camping is permitted on the grounds. Cost \$25 per site/family per night payable to CCSKC.
