<b>3.3.</b>	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a <b>HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST</b> on the upper torso.
<b>3.4.</b>	Karts can be retrieved via the Out Grid at the discretion of the Clerk of Course or Grid Marshall
<b>4.</b>	<b>ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS</b>
<b>4.1.</b>	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
