<b>3.3.</b>	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a <b>HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST</b> on the upper torso.
<b>3.4.</b>	Karts can be retrieved via entry through out-grid gate or gate at bottom of circuit as directed by Clerk of Course.
