Harassment or abuse in sport can have devastating effects not only for individuals involved, but also for the sporting organisation. It can result in legal liability, low morale, higher turnover of volunteers and long-term damage to the sports and club's image and reputation.

To prevent these destructive and harmful outcomes from occurring our sport has implemented practices and procedures which are outlined in the Karting Manual and in the State Policies and Guidelines.

Member protection is also about effective risk management of the two biggest risks to our sport – losing participants and harming members. Any instances where members feel harassed or abused should be reported to the appropriate Karting (New South Wales) Inc. Official or if this is not feasible to the State Office of Karting (New South Wales) Inc.
