STATE RACE CALENDAR CHANGES**

The annual race meeting calendar is organised by the State Karting Council, in consultation with the individual clubs, prior to each racing year. It is set out to minimise clashes between adjoining clubs and between “major” race meetings. This is obviously in the best interest of the clubs and the karter.

Once the race calendar is finally adopted by the SKC, changes to the adopted race calendar can only be approved by the SKC.

The calendar change can be approved by way of a e-mail vote of all clubs in accordance with the adopted State Policy.

Application for the change must be made a minimum of six weeks prior to the proposed event. A non-refundable application fee of \$110.00 will apply and must accompany the request.

The SKC will be given 10 days to respond to the e-mail vote. The host club will be responsible for the preparation of the information to be sent to the clubs, in support of the change.

Any club may request a letter of objection be distributed to all voting clubs within the 10 day voting period.

Exceptions

A request from the National Karting Council or National Executive, for a date to be provided for a National Championship or “major promotional meeting” can be approved by the Board.
