<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ My name is: Peter Brien, I will be the Clerk of Course for this event. ▪ Chief Steward is Wayne Bradwell ▪ Other officials as listed on Supplementary Regulations and any Bulletins issued. ▪ This meeting is run under KNSW Permit and conducted under KNSW Race Rules as per latest Karting Manual, Supplementary Regulations and any Bulletins in force. 	
<p>DUTY OF CARE</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Motor racing is dangerous and accidents can happen. Please comply with all directions given by all Officials of this meeting. All care is taken to protect you but you are warned that there is a possibility of an accident causing injury, death or property damages. • Anyone entering the track, MUST be done under the direction of officials and must wear a safety vest/high vis shirt and closed in shoes. • Parents / Guardian / Pit Crew who wish to assist with the starting or removal of karts must do so within the rules & under direction of officials. • Accidents – please allow officials to coordinate all help needed. • If : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ In the last fourteen (14) days you are aware that you have been in contact with a known or suspected case of COVID-19; or ○ You have been overseas or have had contact with someone that has been overseas in the last fourteen (14) days; or ○ You have any symptoms consistent with COVID-19 (including temperature, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, fever) <p>THEN – you should NOT be here and are immediately instructed that you MUST LEAVE</p>
<p>ALCOHOL / FLAME</p>	<p>There is strictly NO ALCOHOL, SMOKING, WELDING OR ANY NAKED FLAME IN THE PIT / PADDOCK, GRID, INFIELD OR PARC FEME AREAS.</p>
<p>WAIVERS</p>	<p>ANY PERSON ENTERING RESTRICTED AREAS MUST HAVE A KNSW LICENCE. (The Ingrid, Outgrid, Parc Ferme or Track). This includes a KNSW Competition Licence, a Pit Crew Licence or a Legal Guardian Licence.</p>
<p>COMPLAINTS</p>	<p>If you have a complaint on any matter, see either myself or a Steward.</p>
<p>BEHAVIOUR</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The use of foul, abusive or threatening language or intimidating behaviour by anyone will not be tolerated. If you have a complaint on any matter, please see myself or a Steward. - When dealing with other people, please be courteous and civil.

STARTING	<p>The Cut-thru will be used on role-up laps when the “yellow arrow board” at turn 3 is illuminated.</p> <p>Formation lap: Form up on track in grid order by the Formation Line. You must remain in position and travel at slow steady speed ready for start signal. From the “Red Formation Line”, it is forbidden to overtake another Driver, irrespective of the number of formation laps.</p> <p>CIK markings: Before start signal is given, the kart must remain wholly within the lanes.</p> <p>10 second starting penalty applies for most starting infringements.</p>
RACING	<p>Moves liable to hinder other drivers, such as premature direction changes, deliberate crowding of karts, or any other abnormal braking or changes of direction, are strictly prohibited.</p> <p>Drivers stopped must move kart to a safe area as quick as possible and retire behind a safety barrier. No walking back to in/out-grid area during racing unless behind barriers.</p>
Flag and light signals	<p>Please be familiar with the flags and lights in use at this Track. If you are new to this Track or are unsure of systems in use, come and see me, the clerk of the course and the systems in place will be demonstrated to you.</p> <p>Race officials will assume you have seen a flag after 2-3 laps.</p>
WEIGHING	All karts to be weighed at any time, and as directed by weigh marshall.
TIMING	<p>Transponder must be fitted and working at all times, during Official Practice and any Competition.</p> <p>Drivers are responsible for their transponders fitting and operation.</p> <p>Please ensure timing officials are advised of any changes.</p>
FORMAT OF RACING	<p>Direction of Driving: Clockwise</p> <p>As per Supplementary Regulations and any Bulletins issued.</p>
RACE ORDER	<p>Will be <u>as posted on the notice board.</u></p> <p>Competitors please check your entry details, correct number / class etc.</p> <p>If you need an endorsement for upgrade, this should have been done with entry.</p>
OTHER	<p>Pit crew entering the race area must wear Hi Vis.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be spread around the track • Must remain in a safe location behind a tyre barrier. • Must be ready to safely assist any competitor. • No person may approach a stalled/stopped Kart until the remaining Competitors have passed, and it is safe to do so. <p>Novice, Rookies and Juniors classes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If insufficient pit crew/ assistances, are not available to assist on track, then the race may not be run until such times as assistance is available. <p>Dogs are not permitted in pits/racing area at any time.</p> <p>No dumping of fuel or tyres at the track, please take them with you.</p> <p>Please keep the Ambulance access clear at all times.</p>

	<p>Please use the rubbish bins provided. Do not leave used tyres at the circuit. When entering or leaving our circuit please respect the local residents and drive slowly and quietly.</p>
