Drivers Briefing

<p>Until further notice, the current practice of holding a drivers briefing at race meetings with all participants present will cease. This will assist in reducing personal contact in line with KNSW Guidelines to Reduce Covid-19 Risk at KNSW Sanctioned Events.</p>

DUTY OF CARE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Motor racing is dangerous and accidents can happen. Please comply with all directions given by all Officials of this meeting. All care is taken to protect you but you are warned that there is a possibility of an accident causing injury, death or property damages. • If there is an incident and the driver is injured, do not remove their helmet. The medical officer(s) will attend. • Anyone entering the track, must be done so under the direction of officials and must wear a safety vest/high vis shirt and closed in shoes. • Parents / Guardian / Pit Crew who wish to assist with the starting or removal of karts must do so within the rules & under direction of officials. • Accidents – please allow officials to coordinate all help needed. • If: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In the last fourteen (14) days you are aware that you have been in contact with a known or suspected case of COVID-19; or • You have been overseas or have had contact with someone that has been overseas in the last fourteen (14) days; or • You have any symptoms consistent with COVID-19 (including temperature, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, fever) <p>THEN – you should NOT be here and are immediately instructed that you MUST LEAVE.</p>
ALCOHOL / FLAME	There is strictly NO ALCOHOL, SMOKING, WELDING OR ANY NAKED FLAME IN THE PIT / PADDOCK, GRID, INFIELD OR PARC FEME AREAS.
WAIVERS	ANY PERSON ENTERING RESTRICTED AREAS MUST HAVE A KNSW LICENCE. (The Ingrid, Outgrid, Parc Ferme or Track). This includes a KNSW Competition Licence, a Pit Crew Licence or a Legal Guardian Licence.
COMPLAINTS	If you have a complaint on any matter during the meeting, see either the Clerk of Course or a Steward. Note that you will be advised if meetings/hearings will be recorded.

BEHAVIOUR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • THE USE OF FOUL, ABUSIVE OR THREATENING LANGUAGE OR INTIMIDATING BEHAVIOUR BY ANYONE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. • WHEN DEALING WITH OTHER PEOPLE, BE COURTEOUS AND CIVIL. • REMEMBER THE KNSW MEMBER PROTECTION POLICY
STARTING	<p>Baulk Line: You will not be permitted to start if you cross this line and you are not under your own power.</p> <p>Rollup lap(s): Yellow lights/flags are displayed for rollups. Form up in Grid order, and once not displayed get ready for a start. Only start racing once you get the Green Light/Flag.</p> <p>If an infringement occurs, a Judge of Fact Penalty will be issued. If karts are not in formation, additional formation laps may count as race laps.</p> <p>Starting penalty of Rear of Field before a start, or +10 seconds after race, will apply for all starting infringements.</p>
RACING	<p>Moves liable to hinder other drivers, such as premature direction changes, deliberate crowding of karts, or any other abnormal braking or changes of direction, are strictly prohibited.</p> <p>Drivers stopped must move kart to a safe area as quick as possible and retire behind a safety barrier. Please keep all safety gear on until racing ceases. No walking back to in/out-grid area during racing unless behind barriers.</p>
FLAGS	<p>Please be familiar with the flags and lights in use. If you are new to this Track or are unsure of systems in use, come and see the Clerk of Course.</p> <p><u>Red Flag:</u> Cease racing immediately – Raise your hand and slow to a stop, on the inside of the track.</p> <p><u>Yellow Flag:</u> Full course Yellow, stop racing, caution required, reduce speed, re-grid ready for restart.</p> <p><u>Flags Displayed with Number:</u> Driver to report to the Clerk of Course within 15mins after race.</p> <p><u>Mechanical Defect:</u> Leave track as soon as safely possible.</p> <p><u>Black & White / Red & White Chequer:</u> Race over / false start. Stop racing and no overtaking on way back to In-grid.</p> <p>Please acknowledge all flags, Officials will assume you have seen any flag after 2-3 laps.</p>
WEIGHING	<p>All karts may be weighed at any time, and as directed by Weigh Marshall.</p>
TIMING	<p>Transponder must be fitted and working at all times. Drivers are responsible for their transponder fitting and operation. Please ensure timing officials are advised of any changes.</p>
RACE ORDER	<p>Will be:</p> <p>Competitors please check your entry details, correct number / class etc.</p>
