Practice	2x10 minute sessions on Saturday morning in combined class/weight divisions were possible. There will be NO Practice on the Friday before the event	
Qualifying	6 minutes per Class. Classes may be combined if required, where possible	
Race	Laps	Grid Determination
Heat 1	10 laps	Based on qualifying results. Fasted Qualifier to grid 1
Heat 2	10 Laps	Based on qualifying results. Fasted Qualifier to grid 1
Pre-Final	12 Laps	Lowest points total from Heats 1 & 2 to grid 1, next lowest to Grid 2 etc
Final	14 Laps	Grid shall be finishing order of the Pre-Final.

POINTSCORE SYSTEM:

Finishing Position Points: (click/select the system used)

- Zero points system (0,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19,20, etc)
- DNF will receive Field +1 point. DNS will receive Field +2 points,
- DSQ will receive Field +3 points.

TROPHIES & PRIZES:

Trophies/awards will be determined by all points count.

Trophies/awards will be presented to the first three places in each Class at each round.

At the completion of the series the points for all three (3) rounds will be totalled and the driver with the highest points score in each class will be determined the winner of the series in each class First, Second, Third place getters for the Series will be awarded at the end of the final round at Lismore

RACE TRACK ENTRY:

Once Karts start moving and the Out grid gate(s) are closed, there will be no further entry of Karts, persons or equipment to the Race Track, until the completion of practice/racing and all Karts are stopped.

KART RETRIEVAL:

Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.
 Pit Crew must only enter the Race Track area when permitted by the Grid Marshall or Clerk of Course, and then only if wearing a **HIGH VISIBILITY** Safety Vest or Clothing on the upper torso.

ANIMALS:

Dogs are allowed in grounds provided they are on a leash at all times and are properly supervised and cared for.

OTHER:

No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.
 No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Track.
 No Kart engine starts any day before 9.00am or during Drivers Briefing.
 Overnight camping is permitted on the grounds. There are no powered campsites

NO FIRES or NAKED FLAMES ALLOWED IN PIT AREA.

One vehicle per trailer in pits. Overflow and additional vehicles to park in car parking area.
 Power cables are used at own risk and must be located high enough above the ground so as not impact with any vehicles or equipment.
 Please keep the Ambulance gate/entrance clear at all times.
