C. MEETING FORMAT

FORMAT OF GROUP/CLASS/DIVISION RACING:

Practice	There will be two practice sessions on the Saturday before racing commences. Each practice session will be for 10 Minutes duration.	
Qualifying	There will be a Timed Qualifying session of 6 minutes at this Meeting.	
Race	Laps	Grid Determination
Heat 1	10 Laps	Based on Qualifying position
Heat 2	10 Laps	Based on Qualifying position
Heat 3	10 Laps	Based on Qualifying position
Day 2 Carby	5 minutes	Random
Final	16 Laps	Grid will be the highest points from Heat 1, 2 and 3 to the front

POINTSCORE SYSTEM:

Finishing Position Points

The 30 back point score system will be used for all race finishing points. i.e. 1st=30, 2nd=28, 3rd=27 and so on with one point being subtracted for each finishing place, with the exception of 1st to 2nd place which will have 2 points subtracted.

The points from all Heats will be totalled to determine Grid positions for the Final, which will be based on highest points to the front.

Non-starters and non-finishers will be awarded a finishing (after all finishers) based on the number of laps completed, from the highest to lowest. In instances of a tie-on laps, the Driver with the lowest grid position will be awarded the lower points.

Any driver excluded from a race will be awarded the lowest points available per class (based on the number of entries) minus 1 point.

P Plate Licence Holders will grid as per M.2.18 - start from where they qualify in the specified Races, or grid as determined by the Supplementary Regulations for all remaining Races.

TROPHIES & PRIZES:

Trophies/awards will be determined by **Final only**.

Trophies/awards will be presented to the first three places in each Class/Division.

Junior and Senior Cup winners will be determined by Points and Club regulations, No points will be awarded to classes with 2 or less participants.

Grey Plates will be presented to the winners of Tag Restricted Masters and 4SS Masters.

Other prizes and awards may also be presented at the discretion of the Club/Organiser.

RACETRACK ENTRY:

Once Karts start moving and the Outgrid gate(s) are closed, there will be no further entry of Karts, persons or equipment to the Race Track, until the completion of practice/racing and all Karts are stopped.

KART RETRIEVAL:

Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

Pit Crew must only enter the Racetrack area when permitted by the Grid Marshall or Clerk of Course, and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY Safety Vest or Clothing on the upper torso.

ANIMALS:



Subject to the applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, no animals are allowed anywhere within the Track precinct, other than Registered Service Dogs.

OTHER:

- No dumping of Fuel or Tyres**, please make your own arrangements.
- No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Track.
- No Kart engine starts any day before 8.30am or during Drivers Briefing.
- Overnight camping is permitted on the grounds.
- Please keep the Ambulance gate/entrance clear at all times.
