## **C. MEETING FORMAT**

### **FORMAT OF GROUP/CLASS/DIVISION RACING:**

Practice	There WILL be 2 x practice sessions of 10 minutes duration. Classes will be combined at the discretion of the series organisers. Time will begin at opening of the out gate.	
Qualifying	There WILL be qualifying at this event. Each session will be 6 minutes in duration.	
<b>Race</b>	<b>Laps</b>	<b>Grid Determination</b>
Heat 1	10 Laps	Grid will be BASED ON QUALIFYING
Heat 2	10 Laps	Grid will be BASED ON FINISHING POSTION of Heat 1
Heat 3	12 Laps	Grid will be BASED ON FINISHING POSTION of Heat 2

Final	14 Laps	Grid will be HIGHEST POINTS TO THE FRONT -Total Points from the 3 x heats. FINAL ONLY COUNTS
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**POINTSCORE SYSTEM:**

The 30-back point score system will be used for all race finishing points, i.e., 1st=30, 2nd=28, 3rd=27 and so on with one point being subtracted for each finishing place, with the exception of 1st to 2nd place which will have 2 points subtracted. Non-Starters and non-finishers will be awarded a finishing position (after all finishers) based on the number of laps completed, from highest to lowest and will receive normal points for this position. In instances of a tie on laps, the Driver with the lower grid position will be awarded the higher points. Any driver excluded from a race will be awarded the lowest points available for the class (based on the number of entries) minus 1 point.

**Finishing positions of the final will determine trophies given out each round**

**TROPHIES & PRIZES:**

Trophies/awards will be determined by FINAL ONLY  
 Trophies/awards will be presented to the first THREE places in each Class/Division.  
 Other prizes and awards may also be presented at the discretion of the Club/Organiser.

**RACETRACK ENTRY:**

Once Karts start moving and the out-grid gate(s) are closed, there will be no further entry of Karts, persons or equipment to the Racetrack, until the completion of practice/racing and all Karts are stopped.

**KART RETRIEVAL:**

Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.  
Pit Crew must only enter the Racetrack area when permitted by the Grid Marshall or Clerk of Course, and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY Safety Vest or Clothing on the upper torso.

**ANIMALS:**

Subject to the applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, no animals are allowed anywhere within the Track precinct, other than Registered Service Dogs.

**OTHER:**

No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.  
No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Track.  
No Kart engine starts any day before 9am or during Drivers Briefing.  
Overnight camping IS permitted on the grounds. There are NO powered campsites. The use of power leads are at own risk and must be high enough above the ground so as not to impact with any vehicles or equipment.  
Please remove vehicles from pits – please park in designated parking areas  
Please be respectful of fellow campers – all generators to be switched OFF by 10pm  
Please keep the Ambulance gate/entrance clear at all times.
